*Because of the COVID-19 pandemic, testing centers across the nation began closing in March 2020. As a result of these closures, Mississippi suspended the licensure testing requirement through December 21, 2021. Therefore, the total number of test takers in AY 2019-2022, AY 2020-2021, and 2021-2022 will not necessarily be equal to the number of program completers. The University of Southern Mississippi's educator preparation program is accredited by the Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation (CAEP).
